My child has never danced before. Can she sign up?

Yes! This is the perfect opportunity to try it and learn more about the Polynesian culture and dance. No experience is necessary. Beginners and experienced dancers are encouraged to sign up! This class is designed for all skill levels.

What should my child wear to class?

An ie lavalava, pareu, or sarong is required. If your child has a pa'u skirt, we recommend that you bring it as well for them to put on for hula basics. Your child should wear comfortable clothes they can move easily in. Jeans, denim, dresses, and skirts are not permitted. Having your child's hair tied back or in a bun is preferred.

Are drinks allowed in the studio?

Yes! Water preferred, please.

We have limited access to the water fountain and advise students to bring their own.

Note: Gum is not allowed at any point inside the studio. No food or snacks, please.

Are parents, other children/guests allowed to come inside?

Only paid and registered students may enter the studio. There is no lobby or viewing area. Drop-off and pick-up only. If you have a friend who signed up, carpooling is a great option!

Where is the studio located?

Studio R Ballet on Crismon and Southern.

Drive around to the back of the building and it's the door to the right of "101". You'll see a white Studio R Ballet sticker on the door and a Tamali'i sticker above the handle.
